RESOLUTION NO. 2001 - 6

WHEREAS: Traffic on Carlos Township Roads is increasing due to continuing residential and lakeshore development, and


WHEREAS: New public roads are being constructed in conjunction with the subdivision of land and the platting process, and

WHEREAS: Douglas County, acting through the Office of the County Engineer, has developed standards for construction of new roads required as part of the subdivision and platting process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CARLOS TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AS FOLLOWS:


1. Carlos Township Road Construction Standards, dated June, 2001, are hereby adopted for construction or reconstruction of all Township Roads in Carlos Township.
2. Current Douglas County Road Construction Standards, required for construction of new roads built as part of the County Subdivision Ordinance and platting process, except as modified herein, are hereby made a part of the Carlos Township Road Construction Standards by reference.
3. The Carlos Township Board of Supervisors may amend the Carlos Township Road Construction Standards as necessary from time to time by Motion at duly authorized meetings of the Town Board.
4. The effective date of the Carlos Township Road construction Standards shall be June 14, 2001.
