**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CREATION OF THE LAKES AREA
EXONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION**

WHEREAS, the Township of Carlos, Douglas County, Minnesota is devoted to encouraging, attracting, financing, promoting, and developing economically sound industry and commerce within the Greater Alexandria Area; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that a body be created within the Greater Alexandria Area, an entity which can undertake the activities necessary to accomplish said development; and

WHEREAS, the Carlos Township Board of Supervisors has determined that it is in best interest of the Township and its residents that an Economic Development Authority be established to encourage, attract, finance, promote, and develop economically sound industry and commerce within the Greater Alexandria Area; and


WHEREAS, the Township of Carlos, Douglas County, Minnesota, believes that it is essential to partner together with the City of Alexandria and the Townships of Alexandria, Carlos, Hudson and LaGrande, to accomplish the said development within the greater community; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Carlos, Douglas County, Minnesota, supports the efforts of the Alexandria Area Economic Development Commission in the creation of the Lakes Area Economic Development Authority to foster said development; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that special legislation be drafted to enable the City of Alexandria and the Townships of Alexandria, Carlos, Hudson, and Lagrande, to establish an Economic Development Authority with the powers afforded under Minnesota Statutes 469.090 to 469.1081.
