South Park Drive Blacktop Project

RESOLUTION FOR HEARING ON PROPOSED ASSESSMENTS

WHEREAS, by a Resolution passed by the Carlos Town Board of Supervisors on November 10, 2005, the Town Clerk was directed to prepare a proposed assessment of the cost of improvement of South Park Drive, by bituminous surfacing; and

WHEREAS, the Town Clerk has notified the Carlos Town Board of Supervisors that such proposed assessment has been completed and filed in the Town Clerk's office for public inspection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWN OF CARLOS, DOUGLAS COUNTY, MINNESOTA,

1. A hearing shall be held on the 5th day of December, 2005, at 7:30 p.m., for South Park Drive, at the Carlos Elementary School Gymnasium, 20 Douglas Avenue, Carlos, Minnesota, to pass upon such proposed assessment and at such time and place all persons owning property affected by such improvement will be given an opportunity to be heard with reference to such assessment.

2. The Town Clerk is hereby directed to cause a Notice of Hearing on the proposed assessment to be published once in the official newspaper at least two weeks prior to the hearing. The Town Clerk shall also cause mailed notice to be given to the owner of each parcel described in the assessment roll not less than two weeks prior to the hearing. Such notices shall provide the information required by law.

3. The owner of any property so assessed may, at any time prior to certification of the assessment to the County Auditor, pay the whole assessment on such property, with interest accrued to the date of payment, to the Town Clerk, except that no interest shall be charged if the entire assessment is paid within thirty (30) days from the adoption of the assessment. The owner may at any time thereafter pay to the Town Clerk the entire amount of the assessment remaining unpaid, with interest accrued to December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year in which such payment is made. Such payment must be made before November 15th, or interest will be charged through December 31st of the succeeding year.
