Carlos Township
Resolution to Authorize JOBZ Acreage Modification

WHEREAS, the Carlos Township Board of Supervisors, Resolution #2003-08, approved June 26th, 2003, designated acreage to be included in the regional application for Job Opportunity Building Zones, and

WHEREAS, Brenton Engineering Company has applied to Carlos Township Board of Supervisors for JOBZ benefits, and

WHEREAS, the current Brenton Engineering Company's property lies outside of the designated JOBZ subzone boundary, and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Department of Employment and Economic Development allows JOBZ boundary modifications to promote expansion of existing industries within JOBZ communities, and

WHEREAS, a JOBZ Subzone Boundary Modification must be approved by County, Township, and School District, prior to the State of Minnesota authorizing the modification, and

WHEREAS, Carlos Township has no additional JOBZ designated acreage to accommodate the request and must solicit acreage from LaGrand Township, Douglas County, and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Carlos Township Board of Supervisors authorize the JOBZ Subzone Boundary modification in Carlos Township and the transfer of acreage, and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Carlos Township Board of Supervisors authorize the State of Minnesota to approve the boundary modification, transferring 17.03 acres from LaGrand Township, parcel number 27-0232-000, to the following parcel numbers owned by Brenton Engineering Company:
