RESOLUTION SUPPORTING ISSUANCE OF OFF-SALE LIQUOR LICENSE

WHEREAS, Chris Anderson has appeared before the Carlos Town Board requesting consideration of an off-sale liquor license for Anderson's Outpost

WHEREAS, M.S. 340A.405 requires the local governing authority to recommend issuance of such a license before the matter can be presented to the County Commissioners:

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of the Carlos Town Board personally know the applicant, and the Board is also aware of the nature and conduct of the business by the applicant at Anderson's Outpost;


WHEREAS, the applicant is fully informed of the regulations, responsibilities and requirements that are associated with being granted an off-sale liquor license;


NOW THEREFORE, it is
