CARLOS TOWNSHIP

RESOLUTION SETTING HEARING FOR MAPPING A TOWN ROAD

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Carlos Township, Douglas County, Minnesota, received a Town Road Establishment Petition calling for the establishment of a 66 foot road and road right of way for Sandhill Lane from East Lake Carlos Drive to South Park Drive; and

WHEREAS, the clerk verified that the Town Road Establishment Petition was signed by not less than eight voters of the town who own real property, or occupy real estate under the homestead or preemption laws or under contract with the state, within three miles of the road; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board intends to establish said road by mapping as provided for in Minnesota Statute §164.35; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing will be held to consider recording said road by adopting an official map of the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Board of Carlos Township, Douglas County, Minnesota, that:

1. A public hearing shall be held on February 4, 2010, at 7:30 p.m., at the Carlos Elementary School located at 20 Douglas Avenue, Carlos MN 56319.
2. A hearing notice will be published once a week for two successive weeks in a qualified newspaper of general circulation that serves the town, the last publication to be made at least ten days before the date of the public hearing.
3. The hearing notice will state that the road to be recorded will be a four-rod road with the official and permanent alignment being 33 feet on either side of the centerline of Sandhill Lane as set forth on the survey map attached hereto.
4. At least 30 days before the hearing, the hearing notice, together with a Release of Damages, will be sent by mail to the property owners directly affected in the town at the addresses listed on tax assessment notices.
