Carlos Township will be installing an emergency siren in the next few weeks. The final location has not yet been determined.

Township Roads

Seal Coating

The township has seal coated Rue de Frenchman and Harmony Hills. The board will be looking to sealcoat South Park and Park Lane next year. By adding this layer of protection, our roads will last much longer.

Miltona Carlos Bridge

As of this time, the planning and design are almost finished. However, since the legislature did not pass a bonding bill, there are no local bridge funds available. Depending on the size of the bonding bill (if they call a special session) will determine if there will be funding. Per Dave Robley, there are quite a few local bridges on the shelf waiting for funding. Worst case, it may have to wait until next year.

Road Projects

The township will be paving Woodsmen Drive in late July or early August. Many of the township gravel roads will be improved this year with additional gravel and blading.

Geo-textile fabric has been installed on Prairie Road east of State Highway 29, and on Carlos Timbers west of CR11.
