


RESOLUTION ACCEPTING ASSESSMENT ROLL  
FOR DECLARING COSTS TO BE ASSESSED FOR CARLOS BLUFFS ROAD  
2010-07

WHEREAS, pursuant to proper notice duly given as required by law, the Carlos Town Board of Supervisors has met and heard and passed all objections to the proposed assessment for the improvement of Carlos Bluffs Road by bituminous surfacing.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CARLOS TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, DOUGLAS COUNTY, MINNESOTA;

- 1) Such proposed assessment, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part of hereof, is hereby accepted and shall constitute the special assessment against the lands named therein, and each tract of therein included is hereby found to be benefited by the proposed improvement in the amount of the assessment levied against it.
- 2) Such assessments shall be payable in equal annual installments extending over a period of 5 years, the first of the installments to be payable on or before December 15, 2010, and shall bear interest at the rate of 8 percent per annum from January 1, 2011. To the first installment shall be added interest on the entire assessment from the January 1, 2011 until December 31, 2015. To each subsequent installment when due shall be added interest for one year on all unpaid installments.
- 3) The owner of any property so assessed may, at any time prior to certification of the assessment to the county auditor, pay the whole of the assessment on such property to the township clerk, no interest shall be charged if the entire assessment is paid within 45 days from the adoption of this resolution; and he may at any time thereafter, pay to the township clerk the entire amount of the assessment remaining unpaid, with interest accrued to December 31 of the year in which such payment is made. Such payment must be made before December 15<sup>th</sup> or interest will be charged through December 31<sup>st</sup> of the next succeeding year.
- 4) The clerk shall forthwith transmit a certified duplicate of this assessment to the county auditor to be extended on the property tax list of the county. Such assessments shall be collected and paid over in the same manner as other municipal taxes.
