Road Issues:

Chairman Meyers will contact R&R that more brushing needs to be down at 7582 East Lake Carlos Drive and also a tree on Sandhill needs to be trimmed. The trees on Bay Lane and the public access have been cut down.

Pike Road: This road is taking a beating. Chairman Meyers will check with Mark Lee to see if there is a different gravel compound that can be used. The board is also looking at adding more chloride to the road.

Judicial Ditch: Dan Lehmkuhl felt it is not worth putting more money into this road.

Ida Pines: There is a steep grade on the inside of the large curve due to paving the road. Chairman Meyers will call Jeff Stabnow and have him take care of contracting to lessen the grade.

Carlos Timbers paving is scheduled to be started next week. Mark Lee will take care of the additional culvert.
