## Primary Election

The township will continue to hold the next two elections, the Primary and the General at the Carlos Town Hall. The township will be using all recommendation from the state to include social distancing, sanitizers, and masks for its poll workers. The township would appreciate all residents voting in person to also use these recommendations for themselves and for their neighbors.

If voting in person poses a concern, please take advantage of voting absentee.

You may do so at the county auditor's office before Election Day.

On the day of the elections, the polls will be open from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM.

## ***Be sure to exercise your right to vote!***

The polling place for residents of Carlos Township will be held at the Carlos Town Hall, which is located in the City of Carlos. The Town Hall is located directly across from the water tower at 210 Victoria Street.

## Am I eligible to vote?

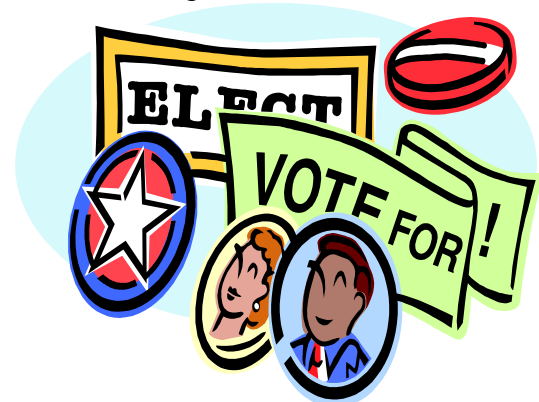
You may register and vote in Minnesota on Election Day if you:

- Will be at least 18-years old on Election Day
- Are a citizen of the United States
- Will have resided in Minnesota for 20 days immediately preceding Election Day
- Have any felony conviction record discharged, expired, or completed
- Are not under court-ordered guardianship where a court has revoked your voting rights
- Have not been ruled legally incompetent by a court of law
- If you are already registered to vote, MN law does not require you to present ID.

## Registering on Election Day

If you are not registered to vote or need to update your registration information, you may do so at your local polling location on Election Day. However, you are required to provide proof of residence and ID when registering on Election Day.

Check out the Secretary of State website or the County Auditor to review which documents are needed to register.

The township election for officers will be on the November 3, 2020 General Election ballot.

The positions up for election are two (2) supervisors for a 4 year term, (Supervisor A and Supervisor B) along with a 4 year term for Treasurer. If filing for a supervisor position, you will need to indicate which office.

The filing period for these offices are July 28 - August 11, 2020.

To file for these offices, papers need to be filed with the clerk before 5 PM on August 11, 2020, as this is the deadline for filing. Contact her at 320 846 0373 to set up a date/time.

### Road Projects

The town board has awarded a construction project to SEPH Construction to reconstruct 300 feet of East Lake Carlos Drive by the channel south of East Lake Carlos Lane.

R&R will begin mowing and clearing brush in the township Right of Ways.

Calcium Chloride has been applied on gravel roads.

The township is continuing to see an uptick in mattresses, televisions sets and other household items being left in the right of way. If you see anyone leaving these items, please contact a township board member.
