

Carlos Township Emergency Meeting

November 13, 2021, 10:00 AM

Members Present – Rod Meyers, Dwayne Waldorf, Bill Krivanek

Purpose for meeting:

To view, measure, and place stakes on the boundary of Township Right of Way for the purpose of clearing brush and a limited number of trees to allow for 35' of clearance along and adjacent to Tolena Road in Carlos Township.

Board Action(s):

Measured 35' from the east edge of Township Right of Way and placed stakes to mark the west edge of Township Right of Way. A few trees that are growing beyond 35' but leaning into and over the Township Right of Way were included in the area to be cleared. A large Ash tree growing 36' from the east Right of Way was determined by the board to be left and not removed but it is to be trimmed to remove any overhanging branches that may be in the road Right of Way.

Mr. Roebke who initiated the request for clearing of the Right of Way, arrived to explain his reason for the request at approximately 10:20 AM.

There is to be no brush or tree removal on the East side of Tolena Road except for a small branch on a crab apple tree that is growing over into the Right of Way near the bend in the road.

Bill Krivanek was to meet R & R at the site to explain the decision on what brush and trees to cut. As a courtesy, He was also going to talk to the landowner of lots 6 and 7 along the West side of Tolena Road, Ms. Julie Thompson, to make her aware of the brush and tree clearing.

Meeting adjourned at 10:50 AM.
